9:00am Arrival to Farm & Opening Circle

Split students into 2 or 3 groups

9:30am Small Group Activities and Snack

10:00am First Activity Station

10:30am Second Activity Station

11:00am Third Activity Station

12:30 Closing Circle

We suggest groups to be divided ahead of time in order to save time and for the field trip to flow with ease.

Students can be grouped up to 20 to flow and interact at each station efficiently.

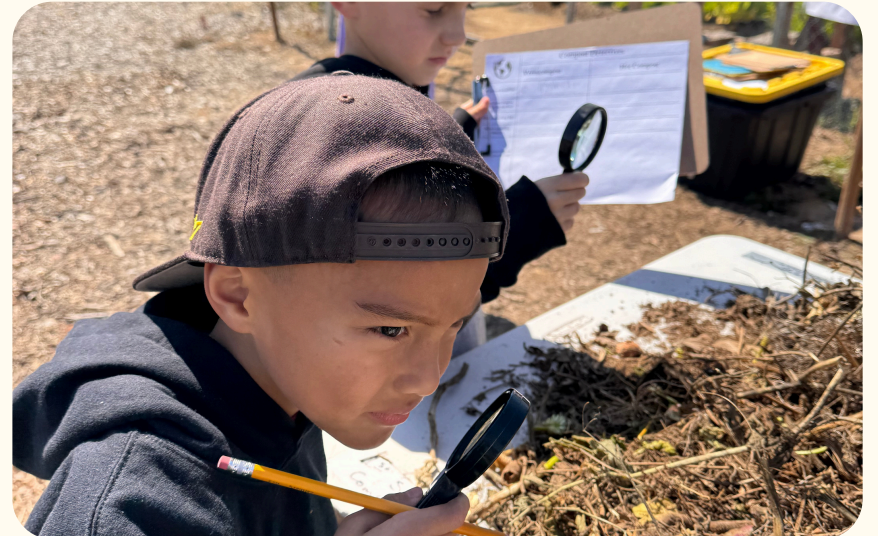
We require a 1:10 Chaperone-Student ratio for support with safety and activities.



## Activity Stations

### 1) Compost & Soil Science Station

Students will explore worm compost activity, food composting, compost detectives: FBI (fungus, bacteria, invertebrates).



### 2) Farm Biodiversity Station

Surrounded by our beautiful farm, students will discover farm biodiversity. Through scavenger hunts students will identify natural pest repellants and learn elements that create equilibrium and diversity in a farm.



### 3) Global Garden & Pollinators

Students can spread their wings and roam around our gardens where they can discover unique herbs from around the world and identify pollinators.

## Price & Policies

For groups of 1 - 30 students (Two groups of up to 15 students) | \$500

For groups of 31 - 60 students (Three groups of up to 20 students) | \$17/student
